***A Marian Parish in West Boca Raton***



This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next, however, are designated as solemnities—special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today on Trinity Sunday we celebrate the mystery of the Holy Trinity, one God in three persons.

Today's Gospel is from the beginning of John's Gospel. The passage we read follows Jesus' conversation with a Pharisee, Nicodemus, about what it means to be born of both water and the spirit. Nicodemus approaches Jesus at night and acknowledges Jesus as a teacher from God. Jesus tells him that only those who are born from above will see the Kingdom of God. Nicodemus misunderstands and questions how a person can be born more than once. Jesus tells Nicodemus that no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. Jesus is essentially explaining Baptism, which we celebrate as a sacrament today. Yet Nicodemus, we are told, still does not understand what Jesus is saying. Jesus continues by testifying to the need to be born from above so that one might have eternal life. After the dialogue with Nicodemus, the author of the Gospel offers his own explanation of Jesus' words. This is what we read in today's Gospel, John 3:16-18.

In the context of today's focus on the mystery of the Holy Trinity, the reading calls our attention to the action of God, who reveals himself in three persons: God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit. God the Father, out of love for the world, sent his Son into the world in order to save it. Through the death and resurrection of the Son, we have been given the gift of the Holy Spirit. As three persons, God acts always as a God of love; he does not condemn the world but acts to save it.

The Gospel also calls attention to the response that is required of us. God's love for us calls us to respond in faith by professing our belief in God's son, Jesus, and the salvation that he has won for us. This profession of faith is a sign of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

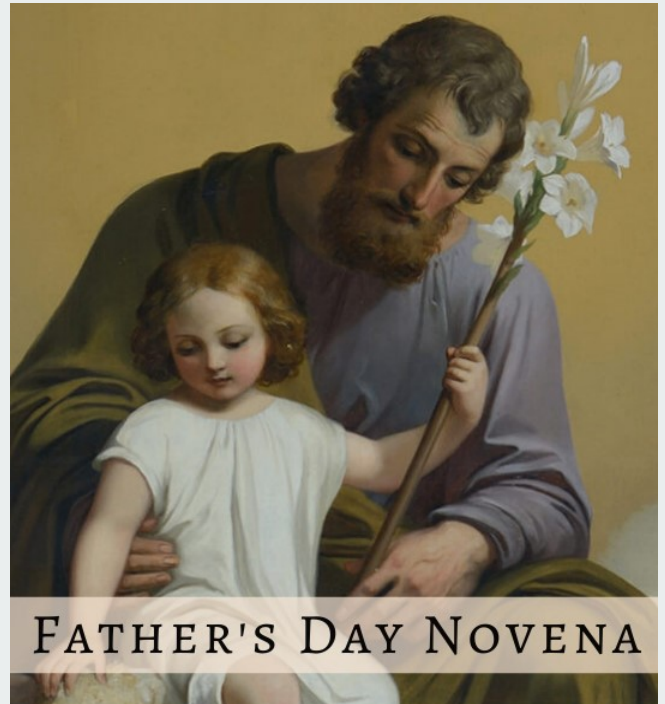

*The notion of three Persons in one God is difficult for anyone to comprehend. Though God is ultimately unknowable, we can know aspects of God through our experiences of the Creator, Jesus the God/Human, and the Holy Spirit.*

*Because of God's great love for us, he sent his Son, Jesus, to save the world. Jesus, in turn, sent the Holy Spirit so that our faith in God and his love would be strengthened. The nurturing experiences of family life also help us to understand and have faith in God's love.*

*Create a family poster together showing all the ways in which your family experiences God's great love. Use symbols, pictures, and words to show how you have seen God at work in your family life and in our history. Then read together today's Gospel, John 3:16-18. Pray together, thanking God for his gift of love. Conclude by praying the Glory Be to the Father or today's Psalm.*

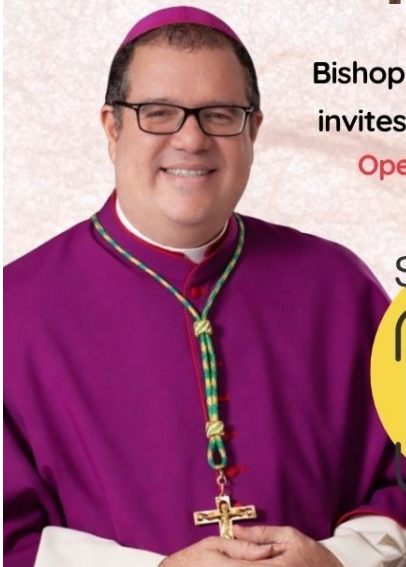

# **AITAPE** **Diocese**

The Catholic Diocese of Aitape is one of the earliest of the nineteen Catholic Church Dioceses of Papua New Guinea, in Oceania. A suffragan diocese of the Archdiocese of Madang, it was established in 1952 and covers an area of 13,117 km<sup>2</sup>. The Diocese area is situated between Vanimo to the west and Wewak to the east, and the majority of the people are subsistence hunters and gatherers who live in village communities. The diocese is in the far northwest of Papua New Guinea, bordering the Indonesian province of Irian Jaya. It is a remote and underdeveloped region, with about 160,000 Catholics distributed in 33 parishes. Spiritual leadership is carried out by 19 priests, religious, many lay parish leaders and the diocesan team of pastoral animation.

Growth of the Church there has been accompanied by challenges, including logistic and economic problems, lack of personnel, long distances and difficult communication routes, depriving the faithful of a regular sacramental life. Despite these challenges, our people are in general industrious, loving, caring and generous. They accompany the clergy on mission journeys to distant villages that may take hours or even days.

The diocese has few resources and little infrastructure. Our parishes are poor, many are in the mountains and they have dilapidated facilities. Most of the facilities in the diocese urgently need renovation. In the short term, there is an immediate need for more missionaries. At the same time, investing in the formation of local seminarians and laity is a priority. Therein lies our future. The diocese runs schools, health facilities, vocational centers and a pastoral center.

Today, we are invited to give Jesus to others. As people of the Eucharist, we can continue the proclamation of the Gospel among our brothers and sisters of Papua New Guinea by assisting them spiritually and financially. Remember, "Acts of love and kindness never die, but in the lives of others they multiply."

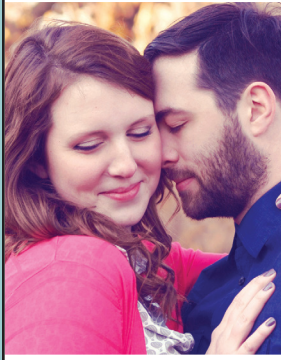
